Location

Caloundra is located approximately 90 kilometres North of Brisbane on Queensland's Sunshine Coast



Caloundra is easily accessible by air, with Brisbane International and domestic Airport 1 hours drive away, and Sunshine Coast Airport near Maroochydore serviced by domestic carriers Virgin Blue and Jet star being 30 minutes drive away.

Regular coach services are available from both airports directly to Riviere on Golden Beach.

The maximum temperature rarely drops below 20 degrees Celsius all year round and the water temperatures ranging from a winter 19 degrees to summer 25 degrees Celsius.
